

Main Risks and Needs Identified by CP Rapid Assessment

Unaccompanied and Separated Children

75% of respondents have acknowledged that children are separated from caregivers.



Children in Armed Forces or Armed Groups

64% of respondents said children are working or being used by armed forces or groups


Psychosocial Distress and Mental Disorder

86% of respondents say children have been reported as having changed their behaviour.

Sexual Violence

CPRA does not highlight any incident of SV on the affected population. However Cluster activities reached 200 survivors out of 3'000 targeted.
